The magnificent sun deck is a spacious terrace including a bar with adjacent sofas/day beds, a luxurious jacuzzi and a choice of sun beds.

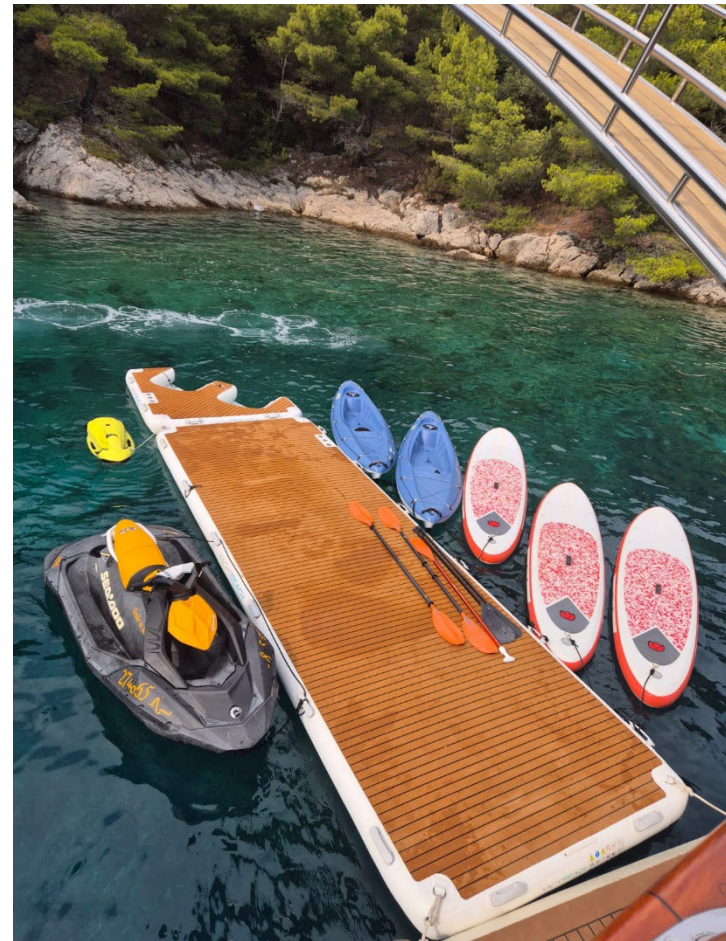

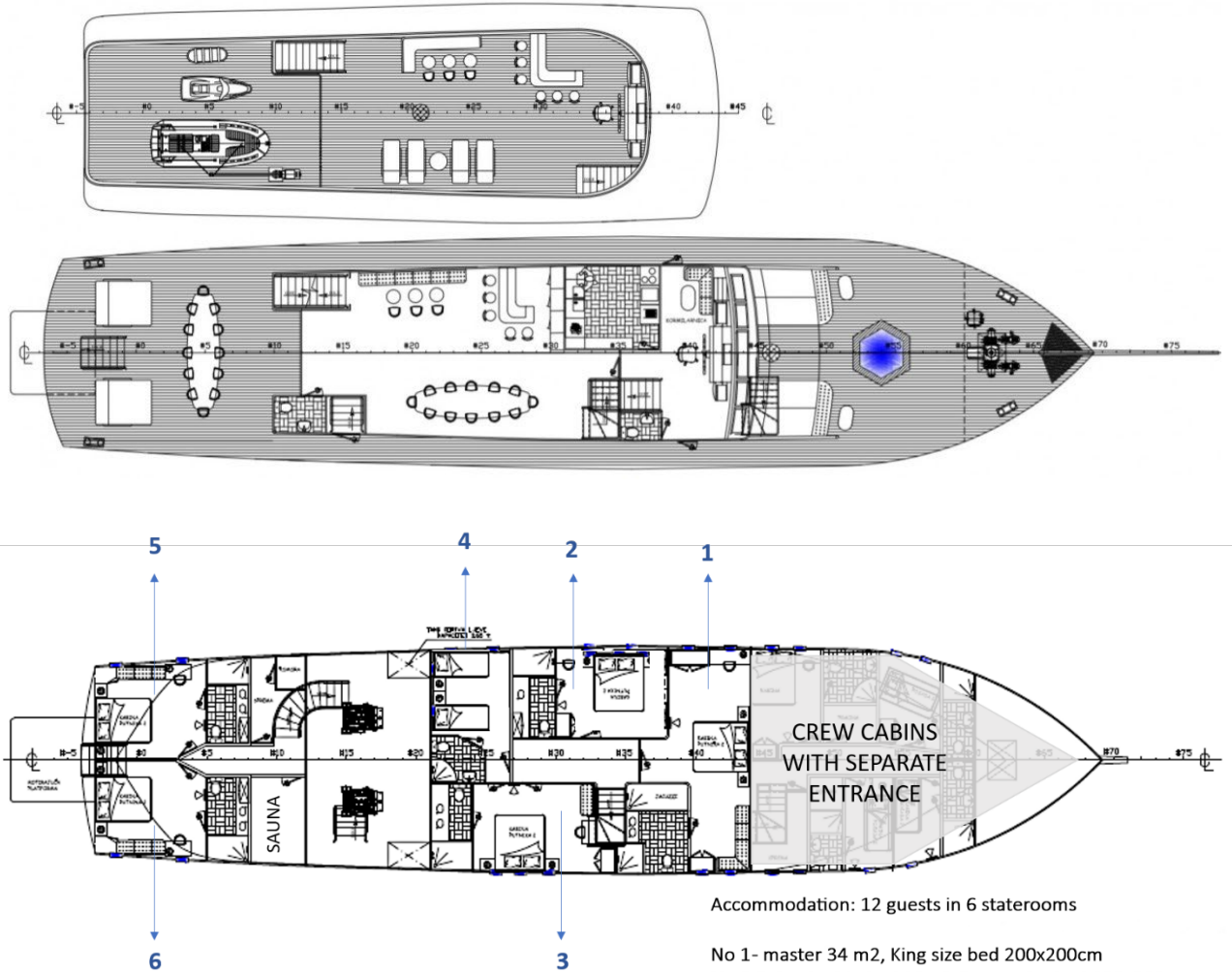

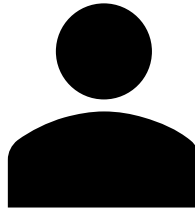


Nena Dumancic | Stewardess

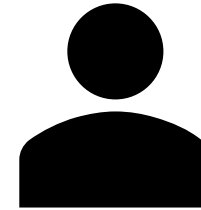


Matea Vitaljic | Stewardess
